She has been smiling and responding with raising her hands, including giving the Hook 'Em sign! She continues to be in critical care and will continue to be for days to come. We are so thankful that our Father has sustained her through this day.

Please continue to pray in these ways:

- **Pray** for protection over Christine's body against bleeding and infection.
- **Pray** for Christine's carotid artery to be made whole.

- **Pray** for her pain to decrease; for her to be comfortable and at ease. As her mental awareness increases, she is becoming more aware of pain.
- **Pray** for the protection of Christine, Cliff and the family against any lies of the enemy; that they will hear only the clear and loving voice of the Father.
- **Pray** for a calm spirit and peace in Christine's mind and heart; that she would know the nearness of Christ.
- **Pray** for Brendan, Cormac, Skye, and Bronwyn to preserve unity and love as they navigate each day.

An image we've had today comes from [Luke 5:17-26](#), when some men were bringing a paralyzed man to lay him before Jesus. They did whatever it took to bring their friend, in faith, into the presence of our Lord. Do this for Christine in your prayers; usher her into the beautiful presence of Christ in faith.


